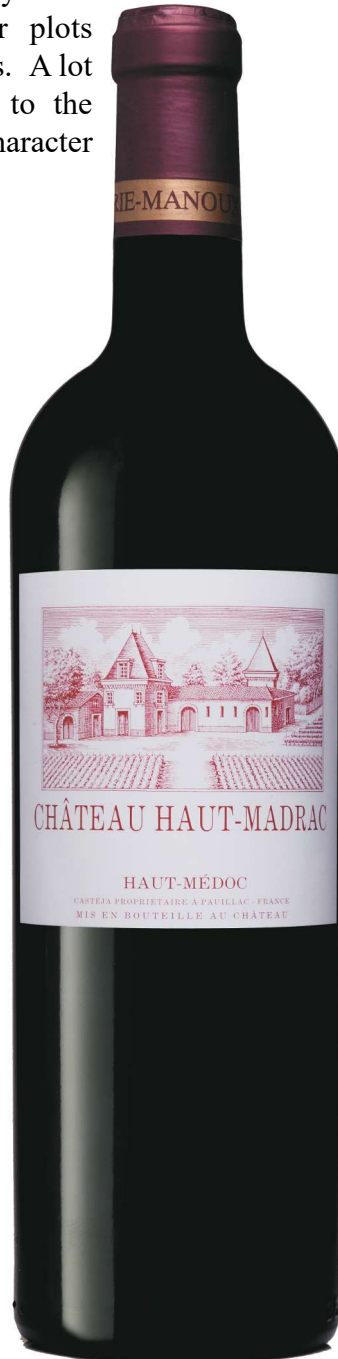
SOIL :

WINE MAKING PROCESS

Fermentation and maceration in stainless steel tanks during 3 to 4 weeks. Aged in oak barrels (about 25 % in new barrels) for 12 to 16 months.



TASTING

"A red with floral, walnut and blackberry character. Some currants, too. It's full and solid with chewy tannins and a flavorful finish. Slightly austere, but it should soften with another year or two."
