The name "Haut-Vignoble", meaning "high vineyard", refers to its most privileged hilltop location, overlooking the valley. Haut-Vignoble Seguin's vineyard produces typical fresh, masculine and well-structured Saint-Estèphe Cabernets, balanced by smoother Merlots adding fruit and harmony.



SOIL:

Gravel and sand

GRAPE VARIETY:

70 % Cabernet Sauvignon 25 % Merlot 3 % Petit Verdot 2 % Cabernet Franc



Traditional fermentation during 3-4 weeks in stainless steel vats. Aging in French oak barrels for 12 to 14 months.
