Haut-Vignoble Seguin, 2nd wine of Château Beau-Site, is made by the same team working for Château Beau-Site. The name "Haut-Vignoble", meaning "high vineyard", refers to its most privileged hilltop location, overlooking the valley. Haut-Vignoble Seguin's vineyard produces typical fresh, masculine and well-structured Saint-Estèphe Cabernets, balanced by smoother Merlots adding fruit and harmony.



VINEYARD

SOIL :
Gravel and sand

GRAPE VARIETY :
70 % Cabernet Sauvignon
25 % Merlot
3 % Petit Verdot
2 % Cabernet Franc



WINE MAKING PROCESS

Traditional fermentation during 3-4 weeks in stainless steel vats. Aging in French oak barrels for 12 to 14 months.



TASTING

"Pretty spice, blackcurrant and grilled orange character, yet perfumed and bright. Medium body with firm tannins and a bright finish. Stones and spices at the end, like white pepper." James Suckling

60 % Merlot
40 % Cabernet Sauvignon
