Château Bassac is on the municipality Sainte-Foy-La-Longue between the two famous rivers of the region, the Garonne and the Dordogne. Château Bassac is the property of the Joanchicoy's family since 1927. Today, Henri Joanchicoy, the third generation, is known for the excellent quality of his red and white wines, both Appellation Bordeaux and both typical representatives of well-crafted terroir wines in the Bordeaux blend, which means of course Merlot and Cabernet (Sauvignon and Franc) for the red.

60 % Merlot

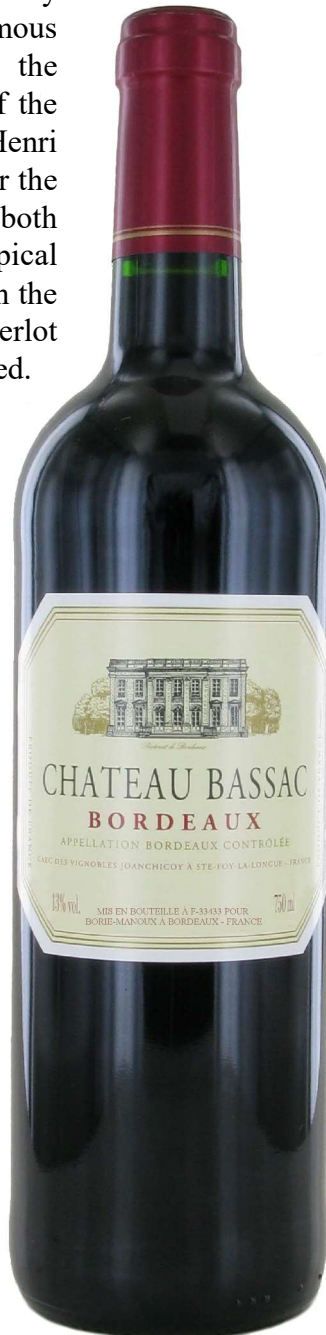
25 % Cabernet Sauvignon

WINE MAKING PROCESS

Fermentation and maceration in stainless steel vats. Maturing in concrete vats.



TASTING

Purplish color. Aromas of blueberries. Mouth with candied and concentrated character.



MATCHING WITH FOOD

At around 16-17° Celsius. Accompanies red and white meat, certain fish, game bird deer, pasta dishes, etc. and cheeses.



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
