Château Bégadan is an exclusivity of Borie Manoux. In the famous Médoc of the Bordeaux region, wine has been cultivated for many centuries. Today, the Medoc is one the most famous wine regions worldwide. On the one hand, Médoc is the name for the whole peninsula North of Bordeaux. On the other hand, Médoc is also the name of the appellation. The Medoc's poor gravel soils and terroirs formed from Pyrenean glaciers during the Ice Age, perfect for Cabernet Sauvignon grapes and Médoc wines.



VINEYARD

SOIL :

Sandy clay-limestone

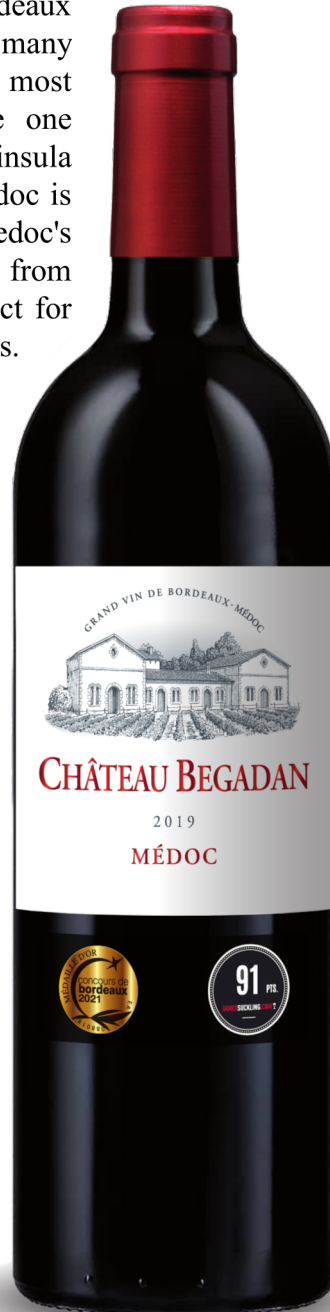
GRAPE VARIETY :

60% Merlot
38% Cabernet Sauvignon
2% Petit Verdot



WINE MAKING PROCESS

Fermentation for 3 to 4 weeks in thermo-regulated cement vats. Aging in oak barrels during 18 months.



TASTING

Dense and deep colour, black cherry. Nose of ripe blackcurrants. Fresh and precise on the palate with well-defined tannins. Soft finish.

BLEND 2019 :

60% Cabernet Sauvignon
40% Merlot



MATCHING WITH FOOD

Dishes cooked in sauce, grilled meats and fishes, and cheese. Serve at 17-18°C.
