Croix de Moussas is in reference to the path of the Cross of Moussas located near the winemaking properties of the Castéja family in the commune of Saint-Sauveur in the Medoc. Médoc means "middle land" because it is located between the Atlantic Ocean and the Gironde estuary. The distinguishing feature of the Medocaine vineyard is the succession of small gravel hills that are called "croups" (a mixture of pebbles, sands and gravel) dominating the estuary.




SOIL:

Traditional vinification. Fermentation and maceration in stainless steels tanks.





Dark colour with purple tints. The nose develops aromas of red fruits. The mouth is light and tasty. In the mouth, the tannic structure is supple and balanced. The finish is suave and woody.

BLEND 2021:

60 % Cabernet Sauvignon 40 % Merlot



Will accompany perfectly meats such as lamb, duck, beef or cheese (Saint Nectaire, Brie or Camembert).



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
