Folie Rouge is a brand created by the Bourceau Vineyards in collaboration with Borie-Manoux. Harvested and vinified entirely at the Vignobles Bourceau (Winemaker from father to son since 1835), these fifty-year-old Malbec are quite rare in the Bordeaux vineyard. Folie Rouge is a red wine from the Blaye - Côtes de Bordeaux appellation, which combines both rarity and elegance.



VINEYARD

SOIL :
Clay, limestone



WINE MAKING PROCESS

Cold pellicular maceration (6°C) before the alcoholic fermentation for 4 days to stimulate fruit extraction. Maturing for 10 months in concrete tank.



TASTING

Graceful and refined, much like a classical ballet dancer, this wine captivates with its deep, intense violet hue. Its silky, well-rounded tannins create a harmonious texture that unfolds into a symphony of aromas. Notes of delicate violet, ripe blackberry, and luscious black fruits intertwine beautifully, while subtle hints of tobacco add depth and complexity to the experience.
