Château Picque Caillou is located at the gates of the city of Bordeaux in the heart of the Pessac-Léognan appellation, the Bordeaux vineyard's historic cradle. In 2006, Paulin Calvet took over the daily running of the vineyard, breathing new life into the estate and giving it new impetus. The wines of Picque Caillou quickly acquired higher levels of quality and consistency, soon attracting the attention of numerous wine professionals. This wine displays superb balance and delicacy.

WINE MAKING PROCESS

Vinification under the control of Professor D. Dubourdieu and V. Lavigne. Barrel ageing for 12 months: 1/3 new barrels.



TASTING

Beautiful purple color. Nose of black fruits with woody aromas. On the palate, balanced wine with a nice freshness and fruity and mineral notes. Good length.

30% Merlot
10% Petit Verdot
